THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Minutes of the December 17, 2019 Board of Supervisors' Meeting

Jr. Davis Construction is requesting approval of Change Order No. 5 in the additive amount of \$17,168.75 for sidewalk connections and ramp adjustments in front of Nemours Hospital, which will

be passed through as a BCID cost.
