SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Resolution 2020-06, Approving a Preliminary Budget for Fiscal Year 2021 and Setting a Public Hearing Date

Ms. Walden presented the Preliminary Budget for Fiscal Year 2121. Included is a column showing the yearto-year variance for each item so the Board can clearly see which items are increasing or decreasing. Overall, the budget is staying the same as last year with total expenses of \$911,167.85. It shows all assessments as on roll assessments but it will break out to show off roll assessments after the final budget is adopted. The biggest change is for Landscaping Maintenance due to Nemours Parkway Phase 7, which will come online during the Fiscal Year. District staff recommended August 18, 2020, as the public hearing date for consideration of the 2021 budget. Ms. Kost requested to have the public utilize the call-in number for participation. Usually, the regular dial in number is for District staff. Dr. Levey stated he has no problem allowing a public dial in number but allowing them to comment is problematic because there is no way to identify who is commenting. Dr. Levey requested a motion to approve Resolution 2020-06.

On Motion by Ms. Duerr, second by Ms. Kost, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Greeneway Improvement District approved Resolution 2020-06, Approving a Preliminary Budget and Setting a Public Hearing Date for August 18, 2020, at 3:00 p.m. at Dockside Lake Nona, 13623 Sachs Avenue, Orlando, FL 32827.

On Motion by Ms. Duerr, second by Ms. Kost, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Greeneway Improvement District ratified the Operation & Maintenance Expenditures paid in April 2020 in an amount totaling \$80,469.78.

Mr. Kaufmann stated Berman Construction, LLC has a joint venture with Tavistock. A discussion took place about the Employee Leasing Agreement. Dr. Levey asked the District Management to report back to the Board about this arrangement and clarify for the Board what is happening.

Recommendation of Work Authorizations/Proposed Services

Mr. Kaufmann presented a proposal for Centerline Drive Phase 2 – Parcel 24E with Donald W. McIntosh Associates, Inc. for additional services to include the design and permitting for the mass grading of Parcel 24E to be included with Centerline Drive Phase 2. These added services are to be Developer funded under the current construction funding agreement.

On Motion by Ms. Duerr, second by Ms. Kost, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Greeneway Improvement District approved the recommendation for Work Authorization for Centerline Drive Phase 2 – Parcel 24E in the amount of \$25,645.00 with Donald W. McIntosh Associates, Inc.

Mr. Kaufmann presented a proposal for Centerline Drive Phase 2 (Segment C) with DEVO Engineering for a geotechnical report and pavement design for the new multi-use trail.

On Motion by Ms. Duerr, second by Ms. Kost, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors for the Greeneway Improvement District approved the recommendation for Work Authorization for Centerline Drive Phase 2 (Segment C) with Devo Engineering in the amount of \$1,800.00.
